## March 1, Ash Wednesday

Lent begins with Ash Wednesday. Mark the beginning of the iourney to the cross with the simple "poor person's meal" of a Pancake Lunch at 12:30 p.m., cost \$5.00. The meal is hosted by the Wednesday Bible Study. Following the meal is the Ash Wednesday Service with Imposition of Ashes at 2:00 p.m. Ashes are the ancient symbol of mourning. Throughout the Bible, when someone goes into mourning they are portrayed tearing their clothes and putting ashes on their heads. We have our foreheads marked with ashes on Ash Wednesday because Lent is traditionally a time to reflect on our own mortality, and to remember that "we are dust and to dust we shall return."

# March 3, World Day of Prayer

This is a longstanding ecumenical observance when

Christians of all denominations gather together to pray for the world. This year the service is being held at the Salvation Army Community Church, 2469 South Main Street. The service begins at 2:00 p.m.

March 5, Soulspace On the first Sunday of the month, Soulspace (7:00 p.m.) offers a time of Taizé style chanting and quiet meditation to begin the month.
